Use of the banquet facilities is provided free of charge to organized youth groups for fundraising purposes with various menus available, including vegetarian. In past years the Stevens Point Elks Lodge has facilitated the various youth organizations in the Stevens Point community in raising over \$60,000 per year through their "spaghetti dinner" fundraising efforts.
